Adoption of Ordinance No. 4

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ILICIT DISCHARGES
INTO TOWNSHIP STORMWATER UTILITIES**

The Board of Supervisors for the Town of Brockway, Stearns County, Minnesota, now hereby ordains that on the 10th day of December, 2013, the Brockway Township Board of Supervisors adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content, a brief Summary follows:

- Section 01: Purpose and Intent – purpose of the ordinance is to protect the health, safety and general welfare of residents
- Section 02: Definitions – Clarifies language used in the Ordinance
- Section 03: Applicability – Ordinance applies to all water entering into storm water drain system unless exempted
- Section 04: Administration – Identifies who will administer the ordinance
- Section 05: Ultimate Responsibility – Ordinance sets minimum standards
- Section 06: Discharge Prohibition – Regulates the discharge of non stormwater into storm water drain system
- Section 07: Suspension of MS4 Access – Regulates when a person may loose access to the MS4 system
- Section 08: Industrial or Construction Activity Discharges – Requires compliance with NPDES Permit
- Section 09: Best Management Practices – Describes best management practices for any activity which may cause or contribute to pollution or contamination of storm water
- Section 10: Watercourse Protection – Watercourses are to be kept by property owners free of trash and debris
- Section 11: Notification of Spills – Requires proper agency to be notified of any spills or illicit discharge into the storm water system
- Section 12: Enforcement – Township options if violations of ordinance are found and consequences for violations of the ordinance
- Section 13: Severability – Validity of the Ordinance should a provision be declared invalid
- Section 14: Repealer – Repeals any portion of a prior Township ordinances that is inconsistent with this Ordinance
- Section 15: Effective Date – Effective date of Ordinance

The, Ordinance No. 4 Regulating Illicit Discharges into Township Stormwater Utilities shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its adoption and upon publication. , will be on file at the Brockway Town Hall and the local library in Rice, MN as well as the Law Library at Stearns County, Minnesota.
